


Items to check before you send your 1637 analyser back to Novatech.

The common causes for unnecessary returns are: -

1) The hypodermic needle is blocked.

Solution: Replace or clear the hypodermic needle using 0.8mm diameter (21 SWG) wire.



2) The filter is blocked. Solution: Replace the filter




3) The filter has been pushed onto the Luhr fitting on the sample line too hard causing it to split allowing ambient air to dilute the sampled gas. Solution: Replace the filter



4) The sample line is blocked. Solution: Clear or replace the sample line



5) The Teflon ferrule on the sample line is damaged or missing. Solution: Fit a new ferrule



6)

The sample line is leaking. Solution: Check that the fitting connecting the sample line to the bulkhead connector on the analyser has been properly tightened. The sample line may have been punctured by a sharp object; replace the sample line.



7) The internal pump has failed. Solution: Replace the sample pump
